**ORDER GRANTING STAY AND
REQUESTING RESPONSE FROM RESPONDENT**


On April 30, 2002, the Government filed its Request for Stay of Proceedings and Motion for Summary Judgment ("Motion"), alleging that the Respondent lacks state authority to engage in the activity for which it seeks registration and claiming that the Respondent has not obtained the necessary state licenses to manufacture a Schedule I controlled substance in California. The Government further argues that the activity for which Respondent seeks registration is not permissible under Federal law, and that Respondent applied for a DEA registration solely as a manufacturer when it should have additionally applied as a researcher. In light of these arguments, the Government contends that summary judgement is appropriate, that there is no need for a hearing, and that Respondent's application should be denied. The Government has requested that a stay of further proceedings be granted until this matter is resolved.

Because the Respondent has not yet had an opportunity to be heard on these issues, I hereby

ORDER that a stay be, and by the same hereby is, imposed on all administrative proceedings in the above-captioned matter and that the outstanding pre-hearing conference deadlines are hereby suspended; and further

ORDER that the Respondent file its response to the Government's Motion, if it so chooses, no later than May 23, 2002.


